
### Help Keep Your Neighborhood Strong! Please Join the DeWeese Ridgecrest Civic Association! Annual Dues are \$10 a Household

In 2015, due to a heads-up by a DeWeese resident (kudos, Karen!) our neighborhood learned of a program through DP&L (now aes Ohio) that provided ornamental cherry trees to beautify public spaces in its service region. We applied for

the program and were granted 50 cherry trees.

In 2016, the trees were planted with DP&L funding along DeWeese Parkway, by Howell Field in Triangle Park, on Idylwilde Boulevard, and a few other places. The trees have thrived and were especially beautiful this year as the photo below shows.

While the good Doctor won't be able to harvest any cherries from these trees, the beauty they bring to our neighborhood is more than sufficient. Thank you DP&L/aes, for providing this welcome harbinger of spring!
